Footnotes

COOKIN N BOOKIN stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the five-sixteenths pole and held sway to the wire. TIZ I IS was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. TATANKA pressed the pace from the outside throughout and finished willingly in the drive. CHROMETASTIC broke in stride to take command at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter and gave way through the final furlong. STOP LAUGHING was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly late. TRISTIN was off slow, raced far back early, moved outside through the turn and found his best stride late. DONTBESHORT raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and did not threaten. TOKING DIRTY lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. LEO DEL LAGO showed no early foot, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention.
