HIT THE JUICE lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out with a furlong to run and was up in the closing yards. GETRDONEGOTRIDD was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from off the rail, gained command with a furlong to run, opened a clear lead but could not resist the winner late. CARRY ON JOHN was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished with a steady bid. SCHU SMARTIE JEAN broke in stride to take command at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, increased her margin through the turn and gave way in the drive while drifting out. U CAN'T TELL ME NO raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. OLYMPIC LIGHTS was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from between foes and failed to rally. MR MAHAL was bumped at the start, showed brief speed and weakened. STREET JIVE lagged throughout.
