Footnotes

SARATOGA'S MAGIC was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, vied with NENE through the final furlong and proved best. NENE raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn, reached the leaders with a furlong to run but could not get by the winner in the drive. WILD FAME stalked the pace of LUX LUTHER from the outside, moved up to take over the pacesetting chores nearing the half, opened a clear lead into the lane but could not resist the closers. HE'S A BARN RAT raced off the pacesetters from the inside throughout and finished evenly. RIGHT APPROACH raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished with some late run. CRITIC lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and was not a factor. MARISHEK was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and failed to menace. ZOHAN saved ground throughout to no avail. LUX LUTHER was away alertly to set a pressured pace and weakened after going a half.
