Footnotes

AKINA showed no early speed, saved ground through the first turn, angled out nearing the five-sixteenths pole, reached the fore with a furlong to run and quickly drew off. SENDIPITY chased the leaders from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the quarter but was no match for the winner in the drive. RENAISSANCE QUEEN was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and lacked the needed closing response. STELLADELNORTH sprinted cleat at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace and weakened after going three-quarters. ICWHATYOURLOOKINAT raced off the leaders from the inside throughout and failed to rally. SHUMKA'S LULLABY lacked early foot, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor. PEPE LE FEU was void of early foot, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. MOJAVE CAT raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened.
