IMPULZIVE KATE was away alertly to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin into the lane and held sway to the wire. NOTES OF FREEDOM lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy to be up for the place. MONTANA FIELDS was never far back, saved ground throughout and finished willingly in the drive. PAT'S BID chased the leaders from the outside and gave way after going a half. TWOBIT'N BILLIE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. DANZGAL raced off the leaders throughout and lacked the needed closing response. ESCORTED lagged early, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. CHASING DEMONS raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and gradually weakened. SARAH SWEETIE was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, weakened, unsaddle on the back-stretch and vanned off. CITY SLEUTH was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention.
