STORMIN' PETER was away alertly to set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear lead in mid-stretch and drew off late. RINGOLEVIO was never far back while racing from between rivals, angled out nearing the sixteenth pole and failed to gain on the winner late. SOUP KITCHEN chased the winner from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. PRANCIN' N DANCIN' was off slow, raced wide through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. SIMPLE JUSTICE was away alertly to press the pace from the inside and gave way through the final quarter. PERFECT KIVA showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. ROOFTOP lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and failed to menace.
