VALID VIXEN QUEEN was away in good order to set a pressured pace from the outside, opened a clear margin nearing the three-eighths pole and drew off through the lane with complete authority. TROUBADOUR LASS pressed the pace of the winner from the outside, was no match for that rival in the drive but clearly second best. PARKERS PIRATE lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with good energy. PLUM NAKED chased the leaders from the far outside and gradually gave way. U SERIOUS raced off the pacesetters from the inside throughout and failed to rally. A MOON LIT RIDE was pinched back at the break, angled out into the lane and did not reach contention.
