RUN ATOM set a pressured pace from off the rail, was well rated while setting the pace, opened a clear lead nearing the half and held off FOOLISH CHOPPER in the drive to prevail. FOOLISH CHOPPER was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and finished with a steady gain. FAST CHARLI chased the leaders from off the rail throughout and finished willingly in the drive. LOOKIN AT GOLD lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with a late rally. M J KNUCKLES chased the leaders from between foes for a half and gradually weakened. SABE chased the leaders from off the rail and weakened after going three-quarters. A STAR IS HERE showed no early speed, raced wide through the first turn and was not a factor. SOUTH CARSON was void of early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and was eased through the lane.
