WORKS LIKA BULLET stalked the leaders from the outside, responded when set down for the drive into the lane and proved best over D DEVIL in the final yards. D DEVIL stalked the leaders from the inside, lacked racing room nearing the three-eighths marker, moved up to offer a bid in mid-stretch but could not hold the winner safe late. MAZAMA pressed the pace from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. LES CRIME raced off the pacesetters from the outside throughout and finished evenly in the drive. POLISH GAME lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. JIMMIE THE GROUCH broke sharply to set a pressured pace and gave way after going a half. SHOOT THE ALARM was void of early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. CORRIENDO BAQUERO was off slow and lagged throughout.
