Footnotes

ALBIHIGHWAY was never far back, raced wide through the second turn, responded to steady handling and wore down AL'S PAL in the final yards. AL'S PAL dueled for the lead from the outside, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and was caught late. SHAKALAKA broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside, angled out in mid-stretch and lacked the needed closing response. AKICKATTHEKAT raced just off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. NATIONAL EVENT lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and found his best stride late. BAGSHOTS DAWN was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not threaten. HAIL MISTER TRUE raced off the leaders throughout and did not reach contention. BENSON ROAD raced off the pacesetters throughout and gradually weakened. SNIPIE showed no early speed, dropped far back and was eased through the lane.
