I WANT SECONDS was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the outside, responded when set down for the drive and held sway to the wire. SIMPERIO was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further into the stretch and finished with good energy to gain the place. COUSIN EDDY was bumped at the start, showed no early foot, saved ground through the turn and finished with a steady rally. OLYMPIC LIGHTS pressed the winner from the outside throughout and could not get by that rival in the drive. PENNY'S IMAGE pressed the pace from between foes and weakened after going a half. NICK'S GOLD was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders, moved far wide through the turn and weakened after going three furlongs. DEE RAIN broke inward, lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor.
