### Footnotes

LOWER TOWN LAD raced off the leaders early, angled outside in mid-stretch, responded to steady urging and was up in the final yards. ICECOLA was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way grudgingly in the drive. DARN COWBOY broke sharply to press the pace from between foes and gave way through the final furlong. REMARKABLE TIMBER pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge approaching the stretch and gave way gradually in the drive. SUMBAS ROCKET was never far back while racing from between foes, moved far outside through the turn and lacked the needed closing response. THE VALID COP was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. CHEHALEM PROSPECT was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. I AM THE POWER lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not offer a bid. WOLFMAN broke out, showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, lost contact with the field and was eased through the stretch.
