MOON DUSTER broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside, gained a clear lead with a quarter to run and held his edge to the wire. SOUND PROSPECT was bumped at the start, raced just off the early pacesetters from the outside, was pushed further out into the lane and finished with good courage. D DEVIL was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from off the rail, drifted out slightly into the stretch and lacked the needed closing response. SLEWDLEDO WAY was bumped at the start, raced wide into the lane and found his best stride late. HAUTE GOLD raced between foes into the stretch and finished evenly. DUSTY BOOTS was never far back while racing from the outside and weakened in the drive. RAPID RHYTHM was bumped at the start, saved ground throughout and failed to rally. KAT JAMMER was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and weakened after a half. NEWPYS NAKED NOGIN showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not menace.
