ECLIPSING MOON was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to take command with a furlong to run and steadily drew clear. SUMBAS ROCKET hopped at the start, moved far outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. REMARKABLE TIMBER broke sharply to set a pressured pace from between rivals and gave way through the final furlong. SUSHIS SON lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and found his best stride late. A. J.'S LIL AMIGO dueled for the lead from the inside and gave way after going a half. LOWER TOWN LAD raced just off the leaders throughout and gradually weakened. BUTTERONMYBISCUIT broke awkwardly, raced wide through the turn and did not menace.
