Footnotes

CATANITA lacked early speed, angled out approaching the stretch, reached ICWHATYOURLOOKINAT with a furlong to run and narrowly edged that rival through a stiff drive. ICWHATYOURLOOKINAT was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside, responded when challenged by the winner in mid-stretch and just missed in a game effort. MOJAVE CAT raced just off the leaders from the inside, lacked racing room from the quarter to the furlong marker, angled outside and finished with good energy. RENAISSANCE QUEEN broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. TRIBUTE TO SISSY was off slow, lagged early, saved ground through the second turn and did not reach contention. ASTRAEA DREAMS chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going five furlongs. SENDIPITY was never far back, raced far wide through the second turn and gradually weakened.
