CALYPTRA was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to take command with a furlong to run and drew clear late. ROCKHILL GOLD showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy. B'S ORCHID lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out with a furlong to run and finished with a late rally. BASIN GOLD was away alertly to set a pressured pace from off the rail and gave way after going five furlongs. NAIL POLISH broke sharply to press the pace from the far outside and weakened after going a half. RICH DEBUT was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened. MONTANA FIELDS lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. CITY SLEUTH raced off the leaders throughout and also gradually weakened. SILK CAPE chased the leaders from the inside for three furlongs and weakened.
