CASTLE PINES was away alertly to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command with three-sixteenths to run and steadily drew off. CHICK MAGNET went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, could not match strides with the winner in the drive but finished well to save the place. AMERICAN MOON raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished with good energy. FIRE BOSS was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and found his best stride late. THRIFTY SCOT lacked early speed, raced off the rail through the turn, came in nearing the quarter and failed to menace. POLISH PETE raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and did not threaten. RUNNING CHARLIE chased the leaders from off the rail throughout and gave way in the drive. PRIEST RIVER showed no early speed, steadied nearing the quarter and did not menace thereafter. The rider of PRIEST RIVER lodged an objection against THRIFTY SCOT concerning the coming in of that rival at the quarter pole causing her to steady PRIEST RIVER and after reviewing the films the Stewards disqualified THRIFTY SCOT and placed him last./
