TOMCAT JAKE was away alertly to set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear lead into the lane and was ridden out to the wire to increase his advantage. BACK OF THE BUS raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn, was no match for the winner but finished well to save the place. MIDDAS GOLD TOUCH chased the leaders from between foes throughout and failed to gain in the drive. BIG DAVE L lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and found his best stride late. CRESENT MCGAIN showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and finished evenly late. l'lBEAMONKEYSUNCLE broke sharply to press the pace from the outside and weakened after going six furlongs. POPULAR LAD raced off the pacesetters throughout, moved outside through the second turn and gradually weakened. PAPA'S FLYN ANGEL lacked early foot, saved ground into the stretch and failed to menace.
