Footnotes

AKA BONES sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, turned back the bid of KEEPPERROCKIN nearing the quarter and quickly drew off through the lane as the handiest of winners. KEEPPERROCKIN broke sharply to chase the winner from the outside, moved up to engage that rival approaching the stretch, was no match in the drive but clearly second best. WILD HANK raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out in mid-stretch but failed to gain on the leaders late. GOOD COP was pinched back at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. SLEWMUNDI chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going three furlongs. DRUM GIRL chased the leaders from between foes and gradually weakened. T C'S LILCICSOCITY was off slow, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. BRANDON R. veered in at the start and lagged throughout.
