### Footnotes

HE'S A GOBLIN was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside with LOW CAL, disposed of that rival into the lane and quickly drew off. THUNDER THORN lacked early speed, steadied nearing the half mile pole, moved outside through the turn and finished with good energy. LOW CAL broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way after going a half. TIZ I IS hopped at the start, saved ground throughout and failed to threaten. SMOKEN SHAM chased the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened. SONJA'S FIRE FLY began to lug out soon after the start and was eased through the lane.
