DELORA JENNA was away alertly, set a clear pace, and remained unchallenged as she drew off in the stretch to win handily. BRUSH STROKES stalked the pace, proved no match for winner, but held a solid second. WANDERING SIREN stalked the pace, swung out five wide at the top of the stretch, but failed to menace. SHESADREAM ran evenly while in mid pack. SWEET SAMI SNIT was unhurried early, produced a mild rally from four deep, but was never a threat. JANIES BOUTINIERRE put out a dull effort. FOXY LOVE showed little. BRILLIANT WILLIE had no speed, and trailed.
