**Footnotes**

MR. ICHIBAN raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, reached the fore inside the furlong marker and quickly drew off. GILDED OPPORTUNITY was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the outside and yielded to the winner through the final yards. INSPECTOR SHAMUS chased the leaders from the outside and finished evenly in the drive. REVOLUTA broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way after going five furlongs. AMANTE MIO lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and failed to threaten. MR MAHAL was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. TIZ I IS was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders throughout and failed to rally. STICKY CANDY was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened. GRIMACING was void of early foot, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention. TOM BOMBADIL was bumped at the start, raced far wide through the turn and was not a threat.
