**Footnotes**

COURT MISCHIEF broke sharply to race just off the leaders from the outside, moved up to gain command with a furlong to run and quickly drew off. SHAMUNDI raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. DEPUTY ALLSTAR chased the leaders from the inside, moved up to offer a bid into the lane and gave way to the closers through the final yards. BLEU TARP lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, moved up to reach a contending position in mid-stretch but failed to sustain his rally. ATTA LORA showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. HE'S A GOBLIN broke out, opened a clear margin before going a quarter and weakened after going a half.
