MISS LYDIA was never far back, raced wide through the second turn, moved up to gain command nearing the eighth pole and held sway to the wire. GOOD LUCK TO US broke sharply to press the pace from the outside, could not match strides with the winner late but finished with good courage. ICWHATYOURLOOKINAT was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the inside and gave way after going three-quarters. EXCUSE MY DUST set a pressured pace from between rivals and gave way after six furlongs. NAMIRAH showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not menace. CHARM SCHOOL GIRL was pinched back at the start, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention.
