Footnotes

GAVINRYAN was off a step slow, moved up from the far outside though the second turn, reached the fore with a furlong to run and held MARVIN STEIN off through the final yards. MARVIN STEIN lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn, engaged the winner a furlong out but could not get by that rival late. HOOFPRIINTSINTIME raced off the leaders early, angled out in mid-stretch and finished willingly. BIG DAVE L lacked early speed, raced between foes through the second turn, angled out into the lane and finished evenly late. TATENATOR chased the leaders from off the rail and gave way through the final furlong. PERFECT KIVA chased the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the half, opened a clear margin and weakened in the drive. COOKIN N BOOKIN raced off the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened. DEBBIE'S FERRARI sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, weakened after going five furlongs and was eased through the lane.
