B. G.'S FANCY ONE broke sharply to press the early pacesetters, gained command with a quarter to home, drew clear in the upper stretch and held his advantage to the wire under steady urging. JUSTIFIABLE was allowed to settle in stride, angled out five wide at the head of the lane and closed willingly. ATTYLYDA was void of early speed, split foes in mid stretch and found her best stride too late. TATTERDEMALION was never far back while racing in good position but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. FACE OFF CIRCLE failed to menace. TRISKABOO vied for the lead into the stretch and tired. IT'S BETWEEN RACES was off a step slow and never threatened. WAJIMA'S GOLD was always outrun. SPEED READ was hustled along from the start to duel for the lead while saving ground and stopped badly after a half mile.
