BULLISHDEMANDS settled racing in hand, came four wide to make a bold bid, wore down BILLS PROUD MARY following a prolonged drive and narrowly prevailed. BILLS PROUD MARY pressed the pace racing three wide, forged command entering the stretch, continued on willingly but was unable to resist the winner late. WINE AT DAWN was unhurried early, came five wide to make a late rally, and was along in time to earn the show. WICE O KAT was allowed to settle into stride, came four wide to make a mild rally, but failed to seriously threaten. GANA HAWK set the pressured pace racing two wide, but was headed entering the stretch and gave way readily thereafter. YOUNGOTTABE THE ONE was hustled along in the second flight and went evenly. OUR GIRL PEARL failed to respond. QUARTERN contended racing along the inside, but came up empty before going a half and dropped out. CHANCY CHANCY was away alertly to dispute the pace racing along the inside, but faltered entering the turn and faded fast.
