TAKE A HARD LOOK broke sharply to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the five-sixteenths pole, opened a clear margin and held off the closing SARATOGA'S MAGIC to prevail. SARATOGA'S MAGIC was never far back while racing from off the rail, angled out into the stretch and was gaining on the winner late. TILLMAN'S IMAGE was off a step slow, began to advance from the inside approaching the stretch and finished with good energy. BAD AS CAN BE lacked early foot, raced far wide through the second turn and finished with a late bid. SPICY FORMULA sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way after going three-quarters. GRIMACING chased the leaders from the outside and also weakened after six furlongs. PRANCIN' N DANCIN' lacked early foot, raced wide through the second turn and failed to menace. PERFECT HAND raced off the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened.
