ALPHA FIRE was never far back, raced wide through the second turn, moved up to offer a bid with a furlong to run and steadily drew off. COUSIN EDDY broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside, could not match strides with the winner in the drive but held on well to save the place. LIQUID INTENSITY was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way in the drive. INITIALIZE lacked early speed, saved ground through the second turn, angled out nearing the quarter and finished evenly in the drive. SMART DEMAND chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. FREEDOM RIDE raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the second turn and was not a factor. SKIPPYJON JONES showed brief speed and weakened. SIMMER DOWN SLEW trailed throughout.
