MAZAMA was away alertly to stalk the pace of INSPECTOR SHAMUS from the outside, responded when set down for the drive, reached that rival with a sixteenth to run and proved best. INSPECTOR SHAMUS broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, also responded when challenged in the drive and gave way grudgingly to the winner late. SEATTLE SAILOR BOY chased the leaders from the outside, angled out in mid-stretch but failed to gain late. ES BAQAVENUE TITAN was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. WHATSINTHESOUPL lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention. SMART AS JIM broke awkwardly, trailed throughout, was unsaddle on the back-stretch and walked off.
