J'S GERRON went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, bridle broke soon after and was confidently handled through the lane while drawing away. LOBOS ROAR was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside, could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished well to save the place. GOTADOWATSISIDIDTOO broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and lacked the needed closing response. SOCKS ON SOCKS OFF showed no early speed, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with some late run. ONE TRUE KNIGHT raced off the leaders throughout and finished evenly in the drive. SOGGY BOTTOM was off slow, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. ONZA DE ORO chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after the opening quarter. BABY GOTHAM pressed the pace from the outside and stopped after going a quarter.
