Footnotes

ICWHATYOURLOOKINAT was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage KNOWN AS LU nearing the three-sixteenths pole, came in to bump that rival nearing the sixteenth marker and was up late. KNOWN AS LU was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the five-sixteenths pole, opened a clear lead, responded when challenged by the winner into the lane, was bumped by that rival nearing the sixteenth pole and just missed. SATURN MOON was never far back while racing from between rivals, checked and angled inside nearing the three-sixteenths marker and finished with good energy. ESPECIALLY CAPABLE raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and finished evenly late. SARAH MAC raced off the pacesetters from the inside early, angled out nearing the quarter, checked soon after and did not threaten thereafter. SUNSHINE SHELLI showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. ACEKINGQUEENJACTEN broke sharply to set a pressured pace from off the rail and weakened after going a half.. SEFAIR lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and did not menace. The trainer of KNOWN AS LU lodged and objection against ICWHATYOURLOOKINAT concerning the bumping incident at the sixteenth pole and after reviewing the films the stewards disqualified ICWHATYOURLOOKINAT from first and placed her second.
