Footnotes

SWISS EXPLOIT sprinted clear soon after the start, raced off the rail while setting the pace, increased his advantage into the lane and was fully extended to hold the closers safe late. GENERAL JOE lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the stretch and finished with good energy. SIMPERIO lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn, angled out further into the stretch and finished with a late bid. TURNTABLE BAY was never far back while racing along the inside and lacked the needed closing response. LITTLE MORDI raced off the leaders from the inside, dropped back nearing the five-sixteenths pole and came back to finish with some late run. TRIBUTE TO SISSY raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the second turn and failed to rally. WEST SEATTLE BOY raced wide through both turns and did not reach contention. TAKING LIBERTIES broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going three-quarters.
