PULZARR'S WINGS was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage nearing the quarter and drew off through the lane. NORTHTOWN raced off the pacesetters early, began to advance nearing the quarter marker and finished with a steady rally. DEBOP lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further nearing the eighth pole and finished with some late run. WAVY ROAD dueled for the lead from the inside for a half and gave way. UNION PRIVEE chased the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. LADY O'DWYER raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and failed to rally. BONNIE VAILLE was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the outside and gave way after a half. BRAZILIAN RED lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not menace. LOW EXPECTATIONS was bumped at the start, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor.
