**Footnotes**

BE A MONSTER was away alertly to set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and steadily drew off. INTHERED ANDBEYOND lacked early speed, raced off the rail through the turn, moved inside into the lane and was up for the place. RICHARD'SDOINGTIME chased the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with a late rally. SEETHATHARBOR chased the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. WHINE AFTER WINE broke sharply to press the pace from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. ANAK ATTACK was fractious at the gate, broke in, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention.
