MIDDA'S GOLD TOUCH was never far back, raced wide through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and was up with a late rush to prevail in the final yards. BLEU TARP broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way grudgingly to the winner in the drive. RICKY RICKY lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane and finished with a late rally. PAPA'S FLYN ANGEL was away alertly to duel for the lead from between foes and gave way through the final furlong. COURT MISCHIEF lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and failed to rally. COREYTHENAVIGATOR showed no early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. IT'S A GOOD DAY raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. HVR WEST CASCADIAN duelled for the early advantage from the outside, lugged out through the turn and weakened.
