RAGING WILDCAT never far back, rallied from between foes coming into the stretch, took charge in mid stretch and quickly drew off to win as much the best. JOJO'S JUSTICE allowed to settle into stride early, swung out five wide near the quarter pole and finished full of run. ANNIKAT pressed the early pace but lacked the needed late response. SONIA'S DREAM stalked the early pace, was five wide on the turn, came six wide entering the stretch and finished evenly. FRANNY GIRL pressed the early pace from between horses and gave way. CHOCOLATE STARR set a pressured early pace, kicked clear on the turn and faltered late. CLASSY ACT was in the second flight early, made a mild bid in the upper stretch but hung in the final furlong. HAINI I ASTAR broke in air to fall behind her field and never recovered.
