Footnotes

JUSTIFIABLE stalked the pace until rallying at the 1/4 pole between horses and getting up in a late surge to win driving. TRISKABOO pressed the leader until she wore down rival at the 1/4 pole to get the lead but was outfinished in the end. SOCIABLE ROOT was unhurried early, rallied at the 1/4 pole between horses but was too late. FACE OFF CIRCLE was hustled up to stalk the pace and save ground but flattened out in the stretch. TATTERDEMALION stalked the pace and was hustled at the 1/4 pole 7 wide but evened out reaching the stretch. GOLDEN HONEY pressed the pace until weakening at the 3/8 pole. OUR CLEMENTINE was allowed to settle, made a mild rally at the 3/8 pole and flattened out at the 1/4 pole and was never a threat. I DOUBT IT was hustled along at the 3/8 pole, swinging out 9 wide but was no threat. IT'S BETWEEN RACES gave way and was no factor. FAWN'S BOKAY set the pace until being used up at the 1/4 pole and dropping back.
