Footnotes

THUNDER THORN broke sharply to set a pressured pace from off the rail, turned back the bid of POLISH GAME into the stretch and proved best over that rival through a prolonged drive. POLISH GAME showed no early speed, moved up quickly to offer a bid nearing the quarter, gained a slight edge in mid-stretch but could not hold the winner safe late. JUSTICE FOR AL was away alertly then rated off the leaders, moved inside into the stretch and finished evenly. BEACON ROCK lacked early speed, moved up for a striking position from between foes nearing the quarter and failed to sustain his rally in the drive. EX TREMELY COOL broke sharply to press the pace from the outside and gave way after going six furlongs. BIGTDAWG chased the leaders from the inside for a half, was pulled up into the lane and vanned off.
