**Footnotes**

GOLDEN N SWEET was away alertly to press the pace from between rivals, gained command nearing the quarter, turned back the bid of DRAMATIC MARINO in mid-stretch and edged clear. DRAMATIC MARINO stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage the winner nearing the furlong marker but failed to sustain his rally in the drive. OUR TAIL WIN raced off the pacesetters early, angled out nearing the eighth pole and finished evenly late. LITTLE MORDI was off a step slow, saved ground through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch but lacked the needed closing response. TATENATOR was never far back, raced wide through the turn and gave way after going three furlongs. SPICY FORMULA set a pressured pace from the inside for three-eighths and weakened. MO'S FLASHY DATE was off a step slow, raced wide through the turn and lagged throughout.
