Footnotes

KNOWN AS LU sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, was well rated through the back-stretch, turned back the bid of SCARLETT'S MARK nearing the half, re-cleared and held sway to the wire. PEPE LE FEU showed no early speed, angled out nearing the quarter, moved inside nearing the eighth pole and finished with good energy. SCARLETT'S MARK chased the winner from the outside, moved up to engage that foe nearing the half and gave way in the drive. NOTES OF FREEDOM raced off the pacesetters early, angled out into the lane and finished evenly. MOJAVE CAT lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. MS. LAVENDER BLUE raced off the leaders early, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the quarter and failed to sustain her rally. LEI OF GOLD chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. CHASING DEMONS raced wide through both turns and gradually weakened.
