Footnotes

TRISTIN raced off the leaders early, angled outside approaching the stretch, reached the leaders with a furlong to run and drew off as a handy winner. SUMBAS ROCKET went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail while setting the pace, could not stay with the winner in the drive but finished well to be clearly second best. BIG IVAN chased the leaders from the inside throughout and gave way in the drive. HIGH ON WINE raced off the leaders throughout and finished evenly through the final furlong. LUCKY TUCKY was taken back at the start, saved ground throughout and failed to menace. INDY'S GRAND SON showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and did not threaten. GOLDEN GIN pressed the pace from the outside for six furlongs, weakened and was eased late.
