Footnotes

SUPERSECRETDEVICE raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn, gained command nearing the three-sixteenths marker and held sway to the wire. ALBIHIGHWAY was away alertly to chase the pace of NUCLEAR PROSPECT from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the half, gained a slight edge but could not match strides with the winner in the drive. KARAKOT raced off the pacesetters early, moved inside through the second turn, offered a bid nearing the three-sixteenths pole but failed to sustain his rally. SAINTLY I AIN'T was never far back, moved up from between rivals to offer a bid nearing the half and gradually gave way thereafter. HE'S A BARN RAT lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten. RIGHT APPROACH showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and failed to menace. NUCLEAR PROSPECT went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and weakened after five furlongs. TUCANNON lacked early foot, raced off the rail throughout and was not a factor.
