SITTINGONARAINBOW was away alertly to press the pace of NICK'S GOLD from the outside, moved up to take command with a quarter to run and drew off through the lane. SOCKS ON SOCKS OFF was never far back while racing from off the rail, could not reach the winner in the drive but finished with good courage. DUBLIN'S LIFFEY raced just off the leaders from the outside throughout and finished evenly through the final furlong. LOBOS ROAR raced off the leaders from the inside throughout and finished with a steady bid. MCNAUGHTY lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and finished with some late run. SMART DEMAND broke in the air, moved up quickly through the back-stretch, angled out nearing the quarter and had nothing left for the drive. NICK'S GOLD was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside and weakened after going a half. TRIP THE WIRE lagged throughout.
