RICH DEBUT broke sharply to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the quarter, increased that advantage in mid-stretch and held off the closing B'S ORCHID to prevail. B'S ORCHID was bumped at the start, lagged early, moved outside through the turn and finished with good late energy. MISS MARLY B was away alertly to press the pace from between foes and finished willingly in the drive. BINKY'S SISTER lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and finished with a steady bid. LEGENDARY MADAME pressed the pace from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. MONTANA FIELDS was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. DAH GIFT raced off the leaders throughout, moved outside through the turn and failed to rally. ONE LITNING QWEEN was never far back, raced wide through the turn and weakened after going three furlongs.
