BETCHA IMA BIGSHOT went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail into the stretch and held sway to the wire. SHANNYN'S PRIDE chased the winner from the outside throughout, could not get by that rival in the drive but finished well to save the place. RICH DEBUT chased the leaders from the inside throughout and finished with good courage. SELINA'S MASK raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished in a steady rally. CRITICAL CHOICE was void of early speed, raced between foes through the turn, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths marker and finished with some late run. KIKI'S DANCE was never far back while racing from off the rail and finished evenly in the drive. JUST CHUB lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and failed to rally. WARREN'S DREAMING showed no early speed, saved ground into the lane and did not reach contention. X PENSIVE IMPULSE was void of early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor.
