DEL MAR BOUND was away alertly, came in sharply to impeded rivals, dueled for the lead from the outside, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and held off his stable-mate late to prevail. SKIING CHUMAREE raced just off the leaders early, bumped with TEMPER THE GOLD nearing the quarter, moved between foes with a sixteenth to run and was getting to the winner late. BELLA CAVALLA also raced just off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and finished with good energy. YAKIMA BOB was bumped repeatedly at the start, chased the leaders from the outside, gave way in the drive and was bumped late. FLOOD CONTROL was bumped repeatedly at the start, rushed to the lead, gave way through the final furlong and was bumped late. TEMPER THE GOLD chased the leaders from the inside, was bumped nearing the quarter and steadied and eased through the lane. The Stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the steadying and bumping incidents and after reviewing the films concluded DEL MAR BOUND had started most of trouble by coming in early and was disqualified from first and placed fifth.
