SWISS CREEK set the pressured pace racing between horses, edged clear into the stretch, and was kept to task to prevail following a prolonged drive. TREASURE BOOTY pressed the pace racing three wide, battled gamely through a long drive, but was unable to reach the winner. D DEVIL was allowed to settle into stride, came four wide to make a late rally, and was along in time to earn the show. LA GRIZZ contended racing between horses, made a mild bid entering the stretch, but lacked the needed late response. BLACK SUIT was hustled along racing four wide in mid pack and went evenly. LES CRIME prompted the pace racing along the inside, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. STATELY JACK FLASH raced four wide in the second flight and failed to respond.
