Footnotes

STREET JIVE broke sharply to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage DO NO EVIL with a furlong to run and proved best over that rival through a prolonged drive. DO NO EVIL was never far back, moved up from between rivals to offer a bid nearing the quarter, gained a slight edge between calls but could not hold the winner safe in the drive. ETERNAL WIND lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. DICEY DEAL raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. SHAKIN SHAMUS sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and weakened after going a half. NUCLEAR PROSPECT hopped at the start, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. WILD FAME was never far back while racing along the inside and gradually weakened. THRIFTY SCOT broke awkwardly, lagged early, saved ground through the turn and did not threaten. SNOWBOUND WAY chased the leaders from the outside, lugged out through the turn and was taken up.
