Footnotes

ITS ALL ABOUT JAKE was away alertly to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the five-sixteenths pole and drew off through the lane as a handy winner. SONJA'S FIRE FLY lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the stretch, moved inside and finished willingly to gain the place. SNORT SNORT raced off the pacesetters early, angled out approaching the stretch and finished with good energy. SEATTLE DINER was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. RAPID PAT was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and finished with some late run. PEPPERJACK PETE was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the outside and gradually gave way. AVANT GARDE pressed the pace from the outside and weakened through the final furlong. BAD ED was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not menace. SUSHIS SON lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not threaten. A. J.'S LIL AMIGO broke sharply to chase the leaders from the inside and weakened after going a half. REMARKABLE TIMBER was bumped at the start, raced wide through the turn and gradually weakened. WHATSINTHESOUP was void of early foot, saved ground throughout and was not a factor.
